

## TAP™ Connector Throwing Club Use

Thank you for purchasing the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club. To ensure safe use, please read the product use instructions/limitations and review them with anyone who will be using the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club.

- The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is intended to be used as a throwing device into nets only; do not throw the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club against hard surfaces or any solid surface that does not absorb the energy of the throw.
- Beware of the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club rebounding off the target net and keep a safe distance from the net when the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is in use; do not allow anyone to stand beside or behind the net when it is in use as a target for the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club.
- The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is a painted, wooden object and will show signs of wear with use. Like a wooden baseball bat, the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club can be damaged or broken with use; inspect the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club before every use and discard if there are any signs of structural damage that affects the integrity of the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club.
- The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club has a painted surface and can become slippery when used. It is recommended the same precautions be taken with a TAP™ Connector Throwing Club as would be taken with a standard wooden baseball bat, such as taping the handle or using a bat grip. VukGripz Bat Grip is a recommended accessory for use with the Throwing Club.
- The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club should be stored in dry environments and away from sunlight and extreme temperatures.

The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is made of solid wood and is designed to be thrown into a net, with intent, at a designated target area. Any net and target selected for use should be capable of withstanding continued intense impact and regularly inspected to ensure suitability for use. It should never be thrown against a hard surface as damage to the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club and the surface may occur. The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club should never be thrown in the direction of another athlete or onlooker.

The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is recommended to be used in blending drills with a regulation baseball; the athlete should not make more than five consecutive throws with the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club without making at least one throw with a regulation baseball. The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is excellent to use as a precursor to, or in addition to, the TAP™ Baseball Training Sock. The TAP™ Connection Ball is also an ideal companion tool to use with the TAP™ Connector Throwing Club in blending drills with a baseball.

The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is warranted for 30 days from the date of purchase. Oates Specialties will provide a one-time replacement for product failure resulting from a material or manufacture defect. The TAP™ Connector Throwing Club is not warranted for damage resulting from misuse, abuse, normal wear and tear, or cosmetic damage.
